

2010 ECBEA Scholarship Award Criteria and Recipients

ECBEA Scholarship General Criteria

- Only students enrolled in the Chinese (Mandarin) Bilingual Program offered by Edmonton Public Schools are eligible. Preference is given to students who have been enrolled since Grade 4 without a break.
- Students in beginner classes are not eligible.
- Marks are important but are not the only criteria in the decision-making process.
- Reference letters and an essay are recommended to submit with the application. Attach a letter telling us about a) your goals and achievements, b) your community involvement, c) your school involvement, d) your accomplishments in sports, arts, music, performances, etc.
- Students most recent mark in Mandarin must be 85% or better, and each mark in English, Mathematics, Science and Social Studies must be 80% or better; unless stated otherwise.
- If marks are provided in letter grades, they will be ranked first by the letter standing (for example A+, then A, then A-). The written portion of the application will be weighed considerably

About the 12 Zodiac Mural Project

The 12 Zodiac Animal Mural Project is a production of ECBEA as a tribute to Chinese culture. The first 3 murals were unveiled during the Chinese New Year of the Tiger Celebration in February, 2010 and the rest will be produced over the coming year until completion during the Chinese New Year of the Rabbit Celebration in 2011. Each mural consists of two hundred and eighty-eight 4" by 4" tiles drawn by students who attend one of the 12 Chinese Bilingual Schools in the Edmonton Public School System. Under the guidance of artist, Lewis Lavoie, each mural was drawn by students from one of the 12 Chinese Bilingual Schools. Each student are free to draw what they want on the tile. The project not only shows them the importance of participation and teamwork, it also depicts each one of us play a small but yet vital role in a larger society.
