BYLAWS

1 NAME

- 1-1. The name of the organization is **The Cathay Community Foundation**. The Cathay Community Foundation is an organization of individuals united to facilitate better understanding between members of the Chinese – Canadian community and other communities through community services, education, sports and recreation, social services, business and charitable endeavors.

2 OBJECTIVES

- 2-1. to encourage fellowship and networking amongst members of the Foundation;
- 2-2. to encourage and foster better understanding amongst all Canadians through community services, educational, charitable, and other programs;
- 2-3. to provide a forum for the promotion of trade, business, education and culture between Canada and China;
- 2-4. to create opportunities and act as a forum for networking between Canadian and Chinese business people and professionals;
- 2-5. to assist newcomers to Canada and to adjust to Canadian way of life through various settlement projects and to encourage them to participate in all aspects of the Canadian society;
- 2-6. to develop and/or acquire facilities where needed in support of the Foundation's objectives;
- 2-7. to raise and provide funding in the form of charitable donations, scholarships, endowments and other financial assistance in support of the work and service of the Foundation.
