- In the area of scholarships and bursaries for teachers of Chinese, John Sokolowski agreed to establish a meeting with Stuart Dunn from Alberta Learning. The purpose of this meeting will be to discuss possibilities regarding scholarships and bursaries for teachers of Chinese.
- The Cathay Foundation is exploring the possibility of raising an endowment for the establishment of a scholarship for teachers of Chinese.
- John Sokolowski agreed to confirm from Alberta Learning whether such endowments could be managed through Alberta Learning. (done; yes, this is possible; sample template is attached)
- Joe Wu agreed to explore the criteria for awards at the University of Alberta.
  
- Regarding awards and student competitions, John Sokolowski agreed to establish a meeting with Xu Lin, Education Officer of the Consulate General of the People's Republic of China from Vancouver to explore possibilities. (done, and meeting will be held April 24).
- Janice Aubry agreed to explore possibilities regarding the role of Edmonton Public Schools related to student competitions.
- Cathay Foundation offered to possibly assist in organizing a student competition for students of Chinese.
